- Having different teachers means you get used to different accents and learn from different teaching styles.

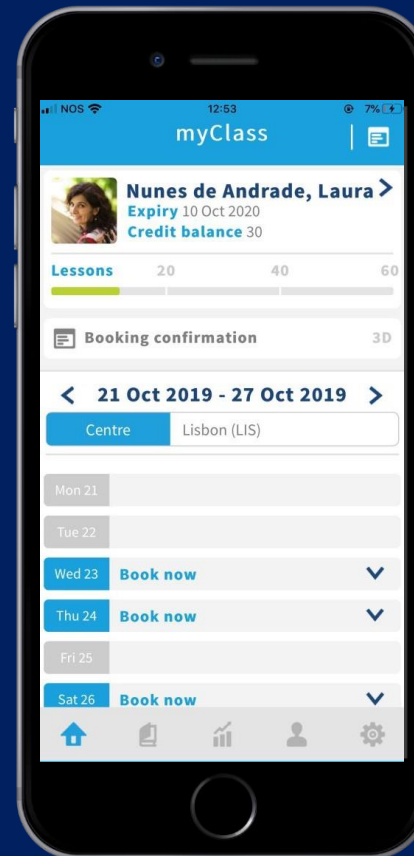


Ian Robson


