

SERVICE OF REMEMBRANCE

Sunday 11 November 2018 will mark the day one hundred years ago that hostilities formally ended after more than four years of battle during World War 1.

This year the Remembrance Day ceremony will be held at the Commonwealth War Graves Commission cemetery at Htaukkyan. The Service will begin at 0900 hrs.

The event is open to the public and all are welcome to attend. Please arrive at Htaukkyan by 0845.

Together with our German colleagues in London and around the world we are encouraging people to ring bells after the ceremony to replicate the spontaneous outpouring of relief that took place in 1918. As news of the Armistice Spread, church bells, which had fallen silent across the UK during the First World War, rang out in celebration. Please join us – and bring your bells.
