## Testing and Quarantine Requirements for Travelers to Myanmar by relief flight (1-8-2022)

- Travelers who can't present the vaccination certificate and a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR
  test result issued at most 48 hours or travelers who have the complete vaccination
  certificate but do not have a negative COVID-19 RDT test result issued at most 48 hours
  before arrival may enter Myanmar only by relief flights.
- 2. Foreigners will not be allowed to take relief flight to Myanmar
- 3. Travelers must submit health declaration card to Health officials present at the airport upon arrival to Myanmar.
- 4. Thermal screening would be carried out in respect of all the passengers by the health officials present at the airport.
- 5. The travelers found to be symptomatic during screening shall be immediately isolated and taken to medical facility as per health protocol.
- 6. All travelers will be tested for COVID-19 by RDT on Day 1 and RT-PCR on Day 5 during their 7 days quarantine period.
- 7. Travelers who tested positive for COVID-19 shall be immediately isolated and taken to a medical facility/treatment center/hotel as per health protocol. Myanmar nationals shall bear the medical cost and other costs related to isolation and treatment in designated private hospital and hotel.
